The competition took place over the school term and ended on June 28th.

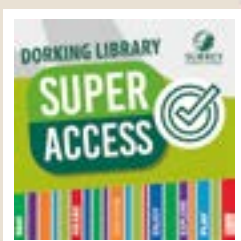
